CLASS ACTION FOR MOBILITY SCOOTER OWNERS

The National Pensioners Convention is bringing a class action legal claim against Pride Mobility Products Limited. The claim is about Pride's breaches of competition law that the Office of Fair Trading found in its decision dated 27th March 2014.

Pride scooter owners may have been overcharged and may be entitled to compensation. The NPC encourages all members to ask affected people to register their interest.

You may be included in the claim if you bought:

- · A Pride brand mobility scooter
- Between 2010 and late 2012
- From any retailer in the UK
- Online or in-store
- Includes Pride scooters leased through Motability scheme
- YOU DON'T have to pay anything
- YOU DON'T have to bring a court claim yourself.
